



# 16 Personalities - Senior EDP Career Planning Activity

## Survey Directions

- If you do not already have one, create a folder/file and title it EDP
- Open a document and enter your name
- Below your name type 16 Personalities and then the date
- Save your document to your EDP FOLDER/FILE
- Log on to <https://www.16personalities.com>
- Click on **TAKE THE TEST** this should take 7-10 minutes
- Take your time and answer all questions honestly.
- Click on “Get your Results”. You will see your personality type with your letters codes in parenthesis example (ISFP-T)

Descriptions of letters or codes:

**The first letter** in the personality type acronym corresponds to the first letter of the preference of general attitude - “E” for extraversion and “I” for introversion.

**The second letter** in the personality type acronym corresponds to the preference within the sensing-intuition dimension: “S” stands for sensing and “N” stands for intuition.

**The third letter** in the personality type acronym corresponds to the preference within the thinking-feeling pair: “T” stands for thinking and “F” stands for feeling.

**The fourth letter** in the personality type acronym corresponds to a person’s preference within the judging-perceiving pair: “J” for judging and “P” for perception.

- Click “Start Reading”
- Read your “Introduction
- On the left of the screen you will see “Your Results” read **“Strengths and Weaknesses” and “Career Paths”**
- Go back to your document and write a reflection about your results. Be sure to include:
  - **Your results (example – I completed the 16 Personalities Survey. The results indicated I am an ISFP-T “The Adventurer”...)**
  - **How your personality, your strengths and weaknesses “match up” with your career choice or career pathway**
  - **Any other thoughts you would like to include**
- Save your document to your EDP/Senior Exit Folder
- Remember to include this information on your senior exit presentation. This is another great way to express why your career choice is a good fit for you.

# 16 Personalities

## Entry Examples

I completed the 16 Personalities Survey and the results indicated that I am "The Consul." Consuls enjoy supporting their friends and loved ones, organizing social gatherings, and doing their best to make sure everyone is happy. I'm good at connecting with others and am a trustworthy partner. This relates directly to my career pathway; as a Physical Therapist, I plan on providing people with therapy and helping them live comfortably.

I completed the 16 Personality Survey. From this I learned that I have a Logician personality. The INTP personality type is fairly rare, making up only three percent of the population. I agree with my results because I will look at facts instead of emotions. I will take the time to think about my actions before I make them. I believe that the logician personality does make a good fit for my career path in Computer Science and looking at the facts will make me do my job well. One of my weaknesses is that I may be insensitive and I will need to be conscious of this when I may work with others. I am happy that I took the time to complete this personality test to better understand my personality.

I completed the 16 Personality Survey. The results indicated that I am an INFP-T, or the Mediator. This indicates that I am introverted, intuitive, more feeling than judging, prospecting, and turbulent. I believe this fits my personality well because I am more of a "keep to myself" person, and I do try to look out for others. I think I am very good at being empathetic towards others and dealing with conflict. However, the turbulent part does describe the weakness I have of occasionally being less calm and collected than most. I sometimes find myself too wrapped up in my emotions and have to remind myself to take a step back. I think the compassion I have makes me a great match for Human Service Career pathways.

I completed the 16 Personalities Survey. My results indicated that I am an ISFP "The Adventurer". I learned about myself in many ways. I learned that I am extraverted, because I am outgoing and love talking to people. I also learned that I am observant, because I don't just go straight into something I like to observe more before. One other thing I learned about myself is that I am assertive because I am very confident with myself and love doing more out of the way. These three personalities would help me with Sports Marketing because in that career you are always talking to new people and trying to make deals.

I completed the 16 personality survey. The results indicated ENFP-A, "The Campaigner". Some of my strengths are that excellent communicator, very popular and friendly, as well as, I know how to relax. These relate to my career path in Fashion Business Management and Fashion Merchandising because I need to be able to communicate well with others. Being friendly allows me the ability to networking with others more easily, this will allow me to make connections in the industry. Another great skill I have is knowing how to relax.
